I paid Davison \$685.00 under the misleading impression that no more money would be needed to present my idea (invention) to a corporation. Director of new Products Frank Weissert clearly explained to me that corporation's budget money for new products and that I am not expected to have that much money to pay for the projects. I have learned now that the \$685.00 only pays for the portfolio. Last week I received the portfolio in the mail and it was very disappointing, it did not appear that a lot of time was put into it. The portfolio was 99% photo copies of other patents and approx 10 half pages of what appeared to be preprinted inserts that were so generic that they could have been inserted into anybodies portfolio. It did not contain any information regarding that a true patent search was completed as promised. I have essentially paid \$685.00 for portfolio comprised of preprinted documents that are use for mass production. I left a phone message for Mr. Weissert to express my serious concerns about the bogus portfolio and he refused to call me back.

I have lost my confidence in Davison to pursue my idea, because of this unfortunate situation communication between myself and Davison have collapse.

I am requesting my \$685.00 refunded.
